



## ● KEY FIGURES OF OUR TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES IN 2019

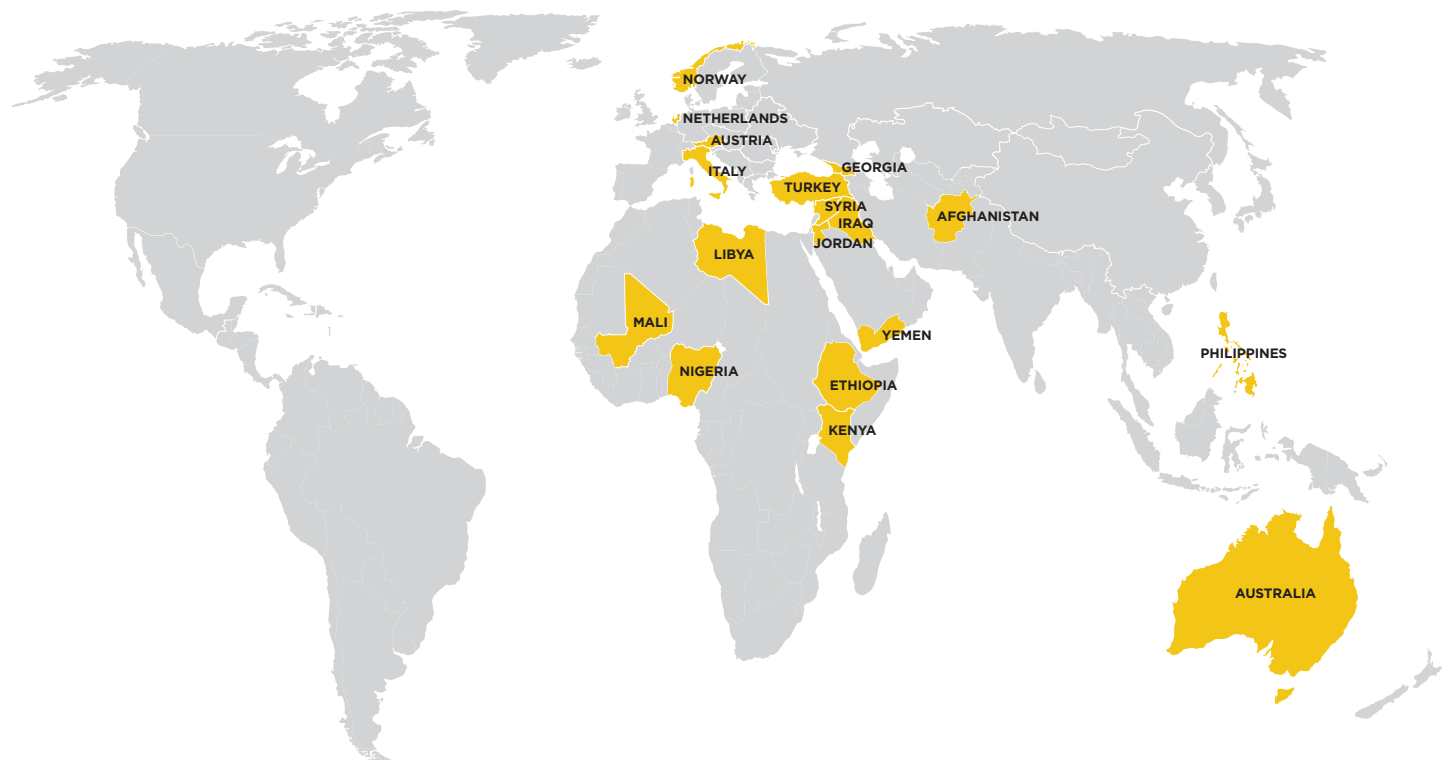
HUMCAP- Humanitarian Capacity is a training and capacity building initiative started in January 2019 and promoted by a group of senior humanitarian professionals.

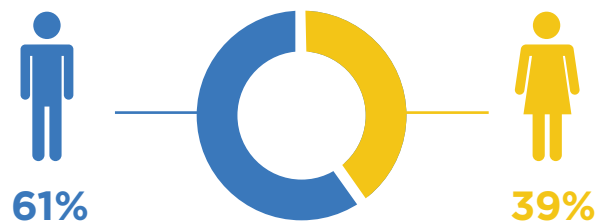

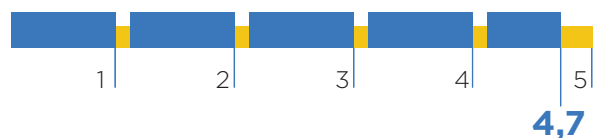
